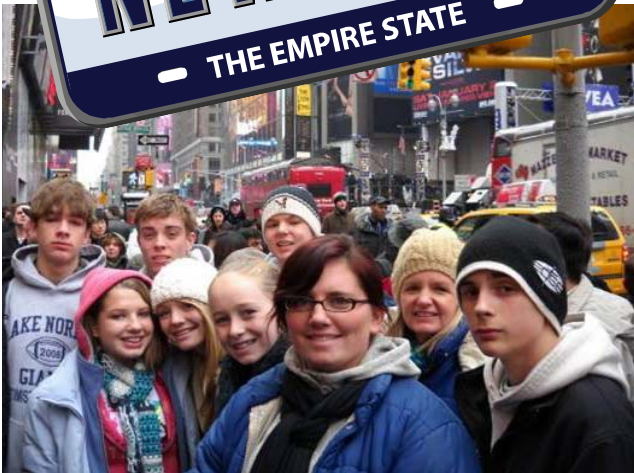

- ◆ Donate a service for the auction (lawn mowing, babysitting, handy-man work, etc.)
- ◆ Sell 50/50 raffle tickets (available soon).
- ◆ Donate money to be used for newspaper ads to advertise this event to the community
